Applications from students with an average points score below this will be considered following publication of results provided that they meet the subject entry requirements and places are available in the subjects the student wishes to study. In this case students will be assessed as to their suitability to study A Levels at PHS based on criteria for 2018 entry as determined by the Governing Body.
