Students have one lesson a fortnight with topics covering financial choices and budgeting with the focus on their next steps.

Students have one lesson a fortnight with topics covering healthy relationships, wellbeing and living in the wider world

Students have 1 lesson a fortnight for half of the academic year. Topics include women's health, pregnancy, harassment, the legal system and pornography.

Students have weekly tutor time lessons with 2 whole morning sessions through the academic year covering financial decisions, work experience, healthy relationships, extremism and influence

Students have 1 lesson a fortnight covering mental health, sex and relationships education, legal and illegal drugs, government and careers

Students have 1 lesson a fortnight covering human rights, relationships, personal safety and drugs, money and careers
