

Funding Allocation from ESFA 2023-24 : £4,522

Costed Plan for Funding :

Using MyTutor to provide additional subject specific support to those students that were impacted from the Covid Pandemic.

Using information gathered from year 11 tutors and the Head of year and for our external students, using the data and information transferred to us. We will firstly target those we feel that are most in need. If we then have funding left over, we will open this out further to students who feel they were severely impacted from the pandemic.

The session run at a time that suits the students and are carried out by vetted and highly capable University students who will have expertise on the exact areas our students require support with.

We have assigned our Mrs Catchpole, our Sixth Form study centre coordinator to look after this part of our offering, she will also ensure that students are attending the sessions and that they are meeting their needs.

As a school and sixth form we will work in line with the following:

A condition of the receipt of this funding, must:

- record all students in receipt of activity funded by the tuition fund in the individualised learner record (ILR and the school census)
- record the use of the funding, including reference to the individual students that receive the support, the needs of those students, the number of hours of tuition delivered, and retain the necessary evidence of the tuition provided and additional cost
- deliver the extra tuition and spend the associated funding in the 2023 to 2024 academic year
- notify ESFA of any unspent funding from this fund at the end of the 2023 to 2024 academic year for it to be reclaimed

The school will identify the students supported with additional tuition and evidence the delivery of provision to the students. In line with usual practice, the school will retain original documents including, for example, attendance records, enrolment records and learning agreements.
