Dear Parents and Carers,

Some of our students, parents and carers have asked about whether we can run Ten Tors through school. Although we do not currently have any school staff who are able to run it, Dynamic Adventures, the group that have been managing our Duke of Edinburgh expeditions, are able to offer a full Ten Tors package.

At this stage I wanted to gauge interest to see if the idea is viable. Please be aware that I cannot promise Ten Tors PHSG teams can be out together as it is very much dependent on the numbers who sign up.

We have some initial information from Dynamic Adventures, but the final pricing will depend on whether teams are doing the 35 mile, 45 mile or 55 mile route.

Students need to be in teams of 6, all doing the same distance.

Dynamic Adventures would offer 8 training walks between September and March and set a fitness programme for students to follow.

The cost to parents would be in the region of £425 per student and would include all 8 training days including an overnight training event and the main event itself. Dynamic Adventures would also come into school twice to talk to participants and parents/carers about kit and first aid. There would also be an introductory talk for parents, carers and students.
