Dear Parents and Carers

Lessons will be running up to and including **Thursday 3rd April**. Year 13 Sixth formers will not be expected in school on Friday 4th April unless they are involved in the Gym and Dance Festival, and final assembly.

Leavers arrangements

Students are to arrive Via the Alton Road gate at 9:15am where the Sixth Form team will be on hand to greet them. We have a bouncy castle booked for the morning and we will provide some light refreshments in the Study Centre. Students are to arrive by the Alton Road gate at 9:15am where the Sixth Form team will be on hand to greet them. They are then welcome to share breaktime with staff to say goodbye informally. They should leave site by **12pm**.

Results
