Dear Parent/ Carer,

It has been wonderful to see our students back at school and fully engaged in their learning. Whilst the majority of our students have been wearing their uniform impeccably, we have seen an increase in the wearing of hoodies and piercings in recent weeks.

In line with the 'home-school agreement' signed at the beginning of term, please could you discuss the following with your daughter:

Non-school jumpers:

Non-school jumpers (including all hooded sweatshirts) are not to be worn during the school day. Any student wearing a non-school jumper or hooded sweatshirt will have this confiscated for the rest of the day: this includes PE hooded sweatshirts. PE hooded sweatshirts may only be worn during PE lessons, at the discretion of the PE teacher.

<u>Jewellery:</u>

The only acceptable jewellery is a watch and one plain stud in the lobe of each ear. No other forms of visible piercing are allowed and this includes having the tongue pierced. Watches, jewellery and other adornments must all be removed before the physical education lesson on health and safety grounds.
