

A Level Geography at Plymouth High School



Yr11 into Yr12 summer transition task:

Read: newspaper articles, magazines, books, or internet sites on the growing Climate crisis. Find out what happened at the COP 26 in Glasgow as well.

I would like you to find out about 1 place in the world that is under threat because of climate change. So for example it could be Wildfires, sea level change, increased storms, salt water incursion, displacement of people, loss of farmland due to desertification, fresh water supply loss, habitat loss / biodiversity loss, etc etc etc

Then I would like you to write a report based on the place you have chosen and the examples of the threats you have researched. Include -

- 1) A sense of place - where is this place , include maps and pictures, what is the place like - use development indicators like HDI etc and population stats.
- 2) What is the issue - go into detail about how climate change is affecting this location, give examples and facts and figures to back up your story.
- 3) What does the future hold - what is being done in the area to tackle the issue? explain in detail what the future might look like in terms of a best case/worse case scenario

This should be handed in on the first day you have Geography in September.
