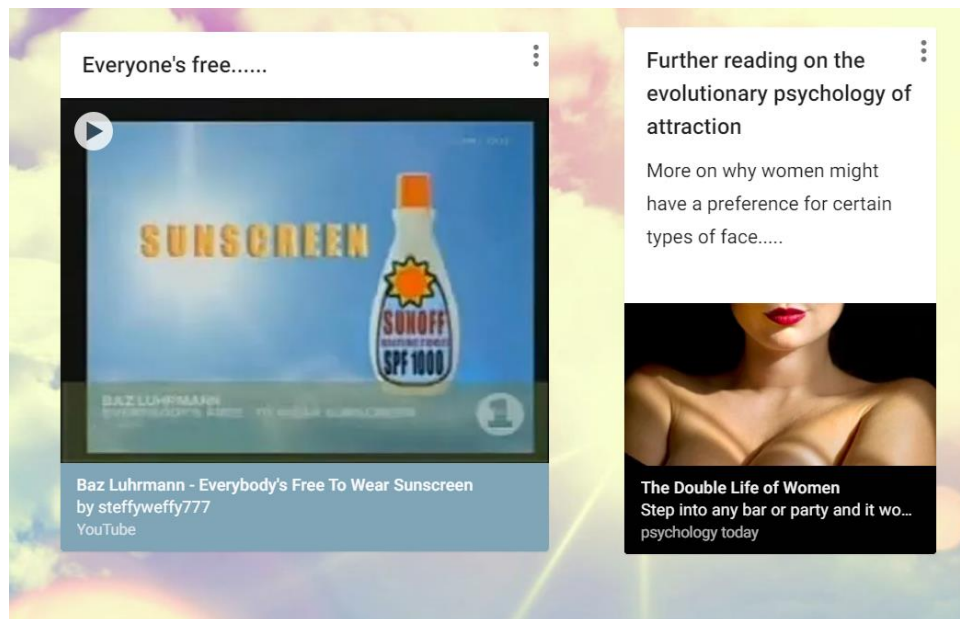


A Level Psychology at Plymouth High School
