GCSE Results day is the 12th August 2021.

Results will be available in school from 8.30am.

Please enter the school via the main gate and make your way down past the courts to the Newman Hall. When you arrive at Newman Hall, you will be directed to enter via the fire doors parallel to the courts.

Parents are asked to wait on the netball courts for their child. Although we anticipate that COVID restrictions may be lifted in some form, we are still mindful of social distancing.

When you enter the hall there will a table for each tutor group where you will receive an envelope containing your results and a letter about your next steps.

Once you have collected your results you will be directed to a languages room to discuss your next steps with a member of staff. This is where we confirm your place in Plymouth High Sixth form if you have met the criteria, and confirm your option choices.

You may also discuss altering your choices if you have had a change of thought or if your results mean that a change of subjects might be needed. If you have not met the entry criteria, we will also discuss alternatives with you on results day.


If it is your intention to attend an alternative sixth form or start an apprenticeship, we would still need a quick chat with you to collect that information.

When you are ready to leave and celebrate your results with friends and family, we ask that you leave the languages corridor or the Newman Hall via the doors next to the lift by room 14.

I hope that you are able to enjoy the few weeks between now and the Results Day in August.
