A'Level results day is the 10th August 2021

Results will be available from 8.30am.

Please enter the school via the main gate and make your way down past the courts to the Newman Hall. When you arrive at Newman Hall, you will be directed to enter via the fire doors parallel to the courts.

Parents are asked to wait on the netball courts for their child. Although we anticipate that COVID restrictions may be lifted in some form, we are still mindful of social distancing.

When you enter the hall there will a table for each tutor group where you will receive an envelope containing your results and a letter about your next steps. Before you leave we would ask you to inform the members of staff on duty in the Newman Hall what your plans are – which university and course, or apprenticeship, travel or employment. It is important for our records that we know your destination.

Once you have collected your results you will be directed towards the languages corridor. There will be an opportunity to discuss your next steps with a member of staff if you wish, room 18 will also be available if you would like to access the UCAS site. When you are ready to leave and celebrate your results with friends and family, we ask that you leave the languages corridor or the Newman Hall via the doors next to the lift by room 14.

I hope that you are able to enjoy the few weeks between now and the Results Day in August.
