Dear Students, Parents and Carers,

I do hope you are all well and looking forward to the summer break.

I write to you with confirmation of the end of term plans, summer examination results days and also details of the start of the new term in September.

The Year 11 and 13 Proms are scheduled to go ahead, notwithstanding any changes to the road map by Government. Year 11 Prom will be at Elfordleigh Country House on Wednesday 21st July and the Year 13 Prom at the Loft on the Barbican on Thursday 22nd July. We are delighted that the proms can go ahead and thank all those involved in advance for their usual exemplary conduct.

Sports Day and the 11+ Practice examination for year 5 are both scheduled for Tuesday 20th July along with the 3.15pm free taster session for Razzamataz. The PHSG staff IT training afternoon is on **Tuesday 13th July and school will finish for students at 12.30pm**. The **last day of term is Friday 23rd July with the school day finishing at 12.30pm**. Those Parents and Carers who would like us to supervise their child until 3.30pm on either of these two days should contact their child's Head of Year. We will assume that parents and carers do not require supervision for their child beyond the school closure time of 12.30pm on the 13th and 23rd July unless we hear from them.

The first day of term for Year 7 and Year 12 students only will be Tuesday 7th September and students from these year groups will need to be in school for the normal time. Students in Years 8, 9, 10, 11, and 13 will not start school until Wednesday 8th September. On Wednesday 8th September, students in all years should arrive at school at the normal time and head for their form rooms.

The results days are as follows. Year 13 A Level results will be available from 9am on Tuesday 10th August and the GCSE results for Year 11 will be available from 8.30am on Thursday 12th August.
