DHSB PTFA Trip to Alton Towers Saturday 7th May 2022 Years 7 - 10

This trip will cost £60.00 per ticket. This includes coach travel and entry to Alton Towers. Coaches leave from Milehouse Park and Ride, Plymouth at **5.00am** and arrive at Alton Towers approximately 10.30am. We leave Alton Towers around 5.00pm aiming to arrive back at Milehouse Park and Ride at around **10.30pm**. **NOTE**: Travelling times may vary to account for comfort stops and road/traffic conditions.

This is a fundraising event organised by the DHSB PTFA. Girls from DHSG and PHSG are also invited. Students from other schools can apply only if they are guests of DHSB, DHSG or PHSG students.

Students will be supervised on the coach and at comfort stops. In Alton Towers they will be free to go their own way. If any problems arise during the day, students can contact a member of Alton Towers staff stating they are with the Devonport High School for Boys organised trip. Guest Services will have contact details for school supervisors present on site and the they can be contacted. **Good behaviour** from all students on the coaches, at the services and at Alton Towers **IS ESSENTIAL**. If an incident occurs the parent / carer will be contacted immediately and future attendance at PTFA organised events will not be permitted.

All students will also be given a contact number for supervisors on site at Alton Towers to allow them to get help in case of emergency.

Parents wanting to more closely supervise their children are welcome to travel as coach supervisors.

We can only run this trip with the goodwill of parent and teacher volunteers. Volunteers help to get the students onto the coaches and act as Coach Supervisors. All Coach Supervisors receive free travel and admission to Alton Towers. Coach Supervisors are not legally responsible for those students allocated to them; normal third party liabilities of the coach companies used, and the Alton Towers organisation apply in this respect. Please tell us on the application form if you can help with this event. It would be useful if you hold a current DBS certificate for working with children, or are in the teaching profession and / or hold a First Aid certificate, but this is not essential. A full briefing will be given to Volunteers before the trip, in the DHSB school Canteen/Refuel on Wednesday 4th May at 4.00pm.

This is a long day so please ensure students bring plenty of things to do on the journey. Students also need bottles of water to drink throughout the day. Fizzy drinks, chewing gum, nuts or other foodstuffs that will cause litter or damage to the upholstery are not permitted to be consumed on the coaches. Expensive items are brought with students at their own risk. The PTFA cannot be held liable for any loss or damage to such items. Please ensure adequate travel sickness medication is provided if necessary.

If your son / daughter has asthma, please ensure that they bring their inhaler(s) with them on the visit. If your son / daughter has any allergies, please ensure that they have all the appropriate medication with them.
