I am pleased to say that our examination year groups have been positive about their experiences to date. Many students have reported that the papers have seemed fair and often very close to what they had expected or practised in class. We are hopeful that all the hard work and effort put in by the students and staff will result in the grades our young people deserve. We are certainly very proud of them, they have approached the examination season with maturity and diligence.

I am delighted to let you know that we have been able to schedule in some improvement works for completion in readiness for the new term. The new sixth form study space will be ready for year 12 and 13 and the new library will be decorated and have new flooring. The MFL toilet block will be completely refurbished. Each toilet cubicle will feature a cold water tap and basin. There will still be the usual hand washing facilities with soap and hot and cold water and the sinks will be set in new vanity units. The History suite will be completely upgraded and redecorated. The classrooms will be brought up to the same standard as the newly refurbished Maths classrooms.
